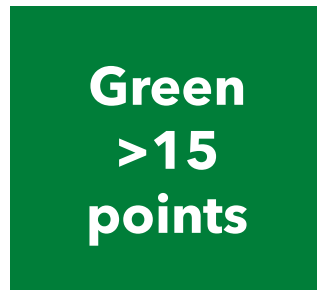

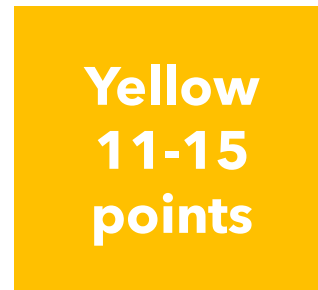
Parish Viability Index



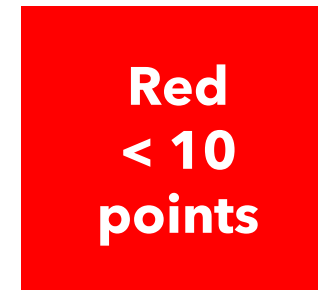
- Measures key areas for projected long term viability of current parishes.

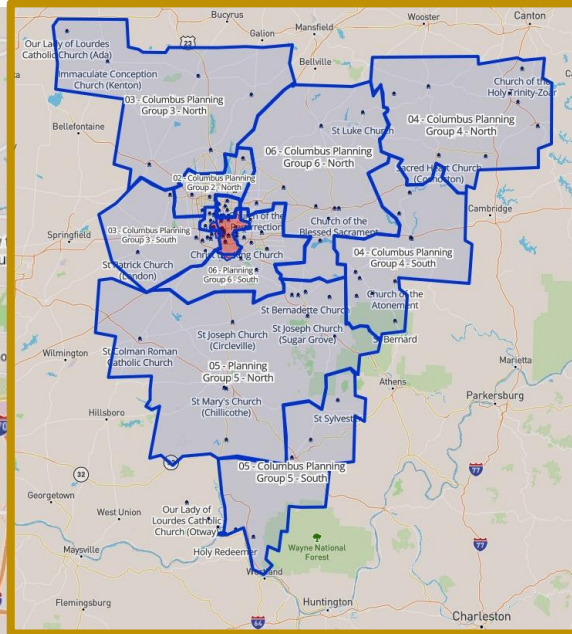
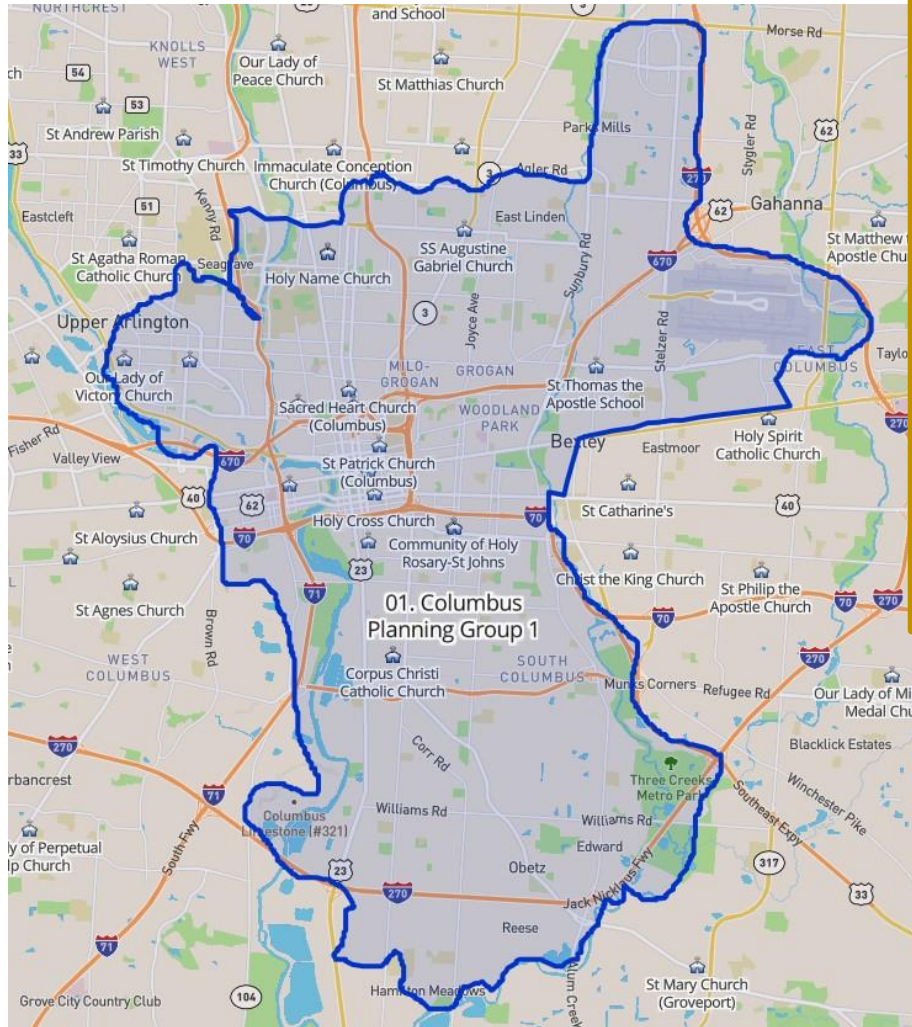

Structural Options



- Within planning areas, draft models were created which grouped some parishes together to foster collaboration. Four canonical approaches exist for parish collaboration:
 1. **One Parish/One Pastor** – May occur through extinctive union or merger of multiple parishes into a new parish.
 2. **Collaborative** – Each parish maintains distinct canonical identity but has one pastor, one staff, and joint programming.
 3. **Multi-Parish pastoring** – Each parish maintains distinct canonical identity, separate staff, separate programming, but shares clergy.
 4. **Deacon Administrator** – A parish or parishes administered under Canon 517.2 with sacramental care provided neighboring priests and overseen by a priest moderator.
